

# Microsoft Windows – Keyboard Shortcuts

The following document aims to show most useful keyboard shortcuts for navigating Windows Operation system.

## Basics

<b>Ctrl + A</b>	Select all items in a window.
<b>Ctrl + C or Ctrl + Insert</b>	Copy selected or highlighted item (e.g., text, images and so on).
<b>Ctrl + V or Shift + Insert</b>	Paste selected or highlighted item.
<b>Ctrl + X</b>	Cut selected or highlighted item
<b>Ctrl + Z</b>	Undo previous action
<b>Ctrl + Y</b>	Redo action
<b>Ctrl + N</b>	When File Explorer is your current window, open a new File Explorer window with the same folder path as the current window.
<b>Windows key + F1</b>	Open "how to get help in Windows 10" Bing search in default browser.
<b>Alt + F4</b>	Close the current app or window.
<b>Alt + Tab</b>	Switch between open apps or windows
<b>Shift + Delete</b>	Delete selected item permanently (skip the Recycle Bin)
<b>Ctrl + F</b>	Search Box (can be used in all office applications, internet explorer)



## MICROSOFT EXCEL

<b>CTRL + C</b>	Copy
<b>SHIFT + SPACE</b>	Select Entire Row
<b>SHIFT + F11</b>	Insert New Worksheet
<b>CTRL + SPACE</b>	Select Entire Column
<b>CTRL + O</b>	Open
<b>CTRL + V</b>	Paste
<b>CTRL + 1</b>	Format
<b>CTRL + N</b>	Create new workbook
<b>CTRL + S</b>	Save



## MICROSOFT WORD

<b>CTRL + C</b>	Copy
<b>F7</b>	Spellcheck
<b>CTRL + SHIFT + N</b>	Apply normal paragraph style
<b>CTRL + BACKSPACE</b>	Delete Previous Word
<b>CTRL + O</b>	Open
<b>CTRL + V</b>	Paste
<b>SHIFT + F3</b>	Capitalization
<b>F4</b>	Repeat most recent action
<b>CTRL + S</b>	Save
